Reminder: Last Day to Place Leaves at Curb for Collection - December 5

The Village of Scarsdale reminds residents that today, December 5, is the final day to place loose leaves at the curb for the 2025 Fall Leaf Collection Program. DPW crews will continue collecting all properly placed loose leaves already at the curb beyond today; however, residents should not place any additional loose leaves out after December 5. This allows crews to safely and efficiently complete end-of-season collections across the Village.

What Residents Should Do

- **Place leaves neatly on the grass near the edge of the road/curbline—not in the roadway.**
- **Keep piles clean.** Only leaves may be placed out; no sticks, branches, grass clippings, or debris.
- **Use biodegradable paper bags** for yard waste such as twigs, dead plants, and grass clippings.
- **Keep piles in front of your own property.**
- **Contractors may bring leaves to the Recycling Center** (110 Secor Road) free of charge with pre-registration.
- **Mulch mowing is encouraged** to promote a healthier lawn and reduce waste.

What Not to Do

- **Do not place leaves in the roadway**, where they create traffic and safety hazards.
- **Do not block sidewalks**, fire hydrants, catch basins, or corners.
- **Do not mix in branches, grass, or other materials**, which prevents pickup and may damage equipment.
- **Do not place piles over rocks, gravel, landscape lights, or sprinkler heads.**

Village Code prohibits sweeping, blowing, or depositing leaves into the road or into any brook, stream, or open watercourse. Property owners are responsible for violations committed by their landscape contractors.
