Village Election Day, March 21, 2017

Voter Registration

Friday, March 10, 2017, is the last day to register with the Westchester County Board of Elections to vote in the Village Election on Tuesday, March 21, 2017. Mail-in registration forms are available at Village Hall, or one may register in-person at the Westchester County Board of Elections, 25 Quarropas Street, White Plains, NY.

In order to register with the Westchester County Board of Elections to vote, you must:

- Be a U.S. Citizen;
- Be 18 years of age by the date of the election in which you want to vote;
- Live at your present address for at least 30 days before the election in which you want to vote;
- Not be in jail or on parole for a felony conviction; and
- Not claim the right to vote elsewhere.

Absentee Ballots

Upon timely application to the Scarsdale Village Clerk, an absentee ballot is made available to any registered voter that will not be in Westchester County on Village Election Day. An *application* for an absentee ballot may be downloaded from the Village's website, <http://tinyurl.com/Absentee-Ballot-Ap>, or requested from the Village Clerk's Office by phone or mail prior to 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 14, 2017, or picked-up in-person until the completed application filing deadline of 5:00 p.m. on Monday, March 20, 2017. No application for an absentee ballot shall be accepted after 5:00 p.m. on Monday, March 20, 2017.

Polling Location

All Election Districts will be voting at the Scarsdale Public Library, 54 Olmsted Road, Scarsdale, New York. Hours of the election are 6 a.m. to 9 a.m. and Noon to 9 p.m.
