Update: Burglary of an Occupied Berwick Road Residence

On Wednesday, April 19, 2017, at approximately 2:16 am, a Berwick Road resident called 911 to report that two men wearing masks were in her home. Both the husband and wife confronted the suspects and a physical altercation between the homeowners and the suspects ensued, with no injuries requiring medical attention reported by the residents. Both suspects were able to flee the residence, at which time the homeowner made the above-referenced call to 911.

Following the initial police response, which included both Scarsdale Police and a Westchester County canine unit, a multi-jurisdiction investigation has been underway to collect and analyze evidence that may help in identifying the perpetrators. In addition, the Scarsdale Police Department has increased both the number and visibility of patrols.

Because the investigation is active and ongoing, specific details related to police tactics and efforts to identify the perpetrators are currently unavailable for public release. No arrests have been made at this time, and additional public information may be released, as available and appropriate.
