Traffic Update: Five Corners and Mamaroneck Road

Con Edison has been undertaking an important infrastructure improvement project in the Heathcote Five Corners area and along Mamaroneck Road from Secor Road to the Middle School. Their work involves constructing a new gas main, which will provide the capacity necessary to support projected local growth in natural gas usage for winter heating needs. Unfortunately, their work also adversely impacts area traffic.

Although the project schedule is fluid, the following insights are offered at this time:

1. The Heathcote Five Corners intersection is expected to continue to experience traffic delays for the next two weeks, or so, with such problems diminishing as ConEd's work moves farther away from the intersection;
2. North/south travelers on Weaver approaching Five Corners should use the Heathcote bypass whenever possible, noting that mandatory Heathcote Bypass detours will occur, as necessary;
3. When westbound Mamaroneck Road is intermittently closed to traffic at Palmer, motorists are advised to turn *right* onto Palmer (Route 125), followed by a *left* turn onto Soundview Avenue, and then a *left* turn onto Garden Road, leading back to Mamaroneck Road;
4. For eastbound traffic on Mamaroneck Road, drivers should follow the detour signs onto Brookby Road. Alternatively, and to avoid the congested Heathcote Five Corners intersection, eastbound drivers should consider turning *left* on Garden Road before reaching Brookby, then *right* onto Soundview Avenue, followed by a *right* onto Old Mamaroneck Road (Route 125) to continue heading east; and
5. Scarsdale Police have positioned an officer at the intersection of Brookby and Heathcote to help reduce vehicle conflicts at that location and to minimize delays for all drivers.

Important updates concerning this project and related traffic impacts will be issued as necessary. Please exercise patience and care when driving in the affected areas.
