### Severe Weather

Residents are cautioned that high winds impacting Scarsdale and surrounding areas are creating hazardous conditions, including downed trees and associated power outages. These conditions are expected to continue through tomorrow morning. Village Hall is presently without power, with no known restoration target. Our Public Safety facilities are experiencing normal operations, but are very busy with storm response activities.

Emergencies should be reported to the Scarsdale Police Department using either 914-722-1200 or 911. If dialing 911, it is best to use a landline for the fastest emergency response.

Please note that local travel is discouraged to facilitate public works and emergency response to conditions identified as the storm continues.

Concerning downed trees and wires, please adhere to the following:

- If you see downed electrical wires, do not go near them. Never attempt to move them or touch them with any object. Be mindful that downed wires can be hidden from view by snow, tree limbs, leaves or water. Always stay away from downed power lines because they could be live.
- Report downed wires to Con Edison and Scarsdale Police immediately. If a power line falls on your car while you're in it, stay inside the vehicle and wait for emergency personnel.
- If your power goes out, disconnect or turn off appliances that would otherwise turn on automatically when service is restored. If several appliances start up at once, the electric circuits may overload.
- Make sure your flashlights and any battery-operated radios or televisions are working. Have a supply of extra batteries. Weather updates and news on electrical service can be heard on local radio and television stations.
